- Kimberly Hutcheson 112 / 264 Traffic Light Thank you Alderman Middlecamp & Alderman Chitszan for bringing this to the council without them it would have not been budgeted for in 2024.
 ULI meeting held on 12/19/23 the downtown business owners were not notified of the meeting & if we want to get the businesses on board there needs to be communication.

Mayor Discussed ULI Group -

New Business:

1) A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE LOW BID SUBMITTED BY SSI, INC. FOR THE COMMUNITY BUILDING RESTORATION PROJECT IN THE CITY OF CAVE SPRINGS, ARKANSAS.

Alderman Middlecamp

• Stated that in 2019 the citizens voted down the Community Building, \$880,000.00 is a lot of money to re-do the Community Building. We now have 6000 people in Cave Springs.

Alderwoman Caruthers

- Stated \$880,000.00 is before the change orders.
- Mentioned that should the Planning Commission not be involved with the ULI group? She questioned is the
 city council jumping the gun approving a bid before the ULI group finishes the assessment?
- We have a lot of critical needs in the city, like a stop light, & fire trucks that are more important due to safety reasons, than having a community building as much as we want one. What options do the ULI group have to contribute to the money?

Alderwoman Velasquez

- Stated in 2019 the voters voted on community building 166 voted for / 210 voted against.
- The current community building is approx. 1711 sq ft workable space inside, the American Legion is 1680 sq ft., the entire fire station is 10,642 sq ft., the training room is 851 sq ft. 1711sq ft. will be cut back due the bathrooms which will equal the American Legion.
- With a city of 6000 with people wanting to have events, etc. court today had approx.54 people attend, the sq ft is not worth it if you do the math. The community building is approx. \$100.00 a sq ft than the new fire station. The new fire station was approx. \$259.00 a sq ft to build, and the community building restoration will be \$360.00 a sq ft.
- Stated she would like the planning commission to look at the plans to see if the cost can come down with their suggestions. The furnishings are horrible and will need to be replaced.
- We owe \$128,000.00 on City Hall and we still owe on the 2020 firetruck.

Alderman Thompson

- Supports historical buildings downtown.
- As a city body we inherit the financial responsibilities. What does the council want to do, renovate, tear down, or rebuild. Would like to get in contact with the ULI group to discuss these options.

Mayor Noblett

• "The City needs facilities and frankly if we decide to throw out our historic buildings and put up metal buildings with fake fronts on them as where people won't look at the side of them when they drive by, we will be just one more city to drive by, and we might as well fold up the city sidewalks."
